Brief details of litigation viz. a. name(s) of the opposing party; b. court/ tribunal/agency where litigation is filed; c. brief details of dispute/litigation	Department of Telecommunications (DoT)  High Court of Delhi  DoT had issued demand notice dated 24.08.2020 for INR 8.56 Crores on STL in respect of its IP-1 registration. The parties were referred to Arbitration and vide Award dated 17.05.2023, the said demand of INR 8.56 Crores was rendered invalid and arbitrary and cost of INR 38 Lakhs was also awarded in favour of STL. Now, DoT has filed petition u/s 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 to challenge the said Award dated 17.05.2023, copy of which has been received by STL on 14.09.2023.
